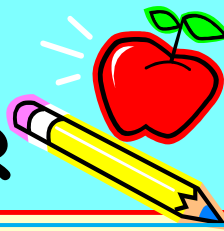

Story Skill: Compare and Contrast

Compare: Find way that 2 or more things are similar.

Contrast: Find ways that 2 or more things are different.

Think about similarities and differences.

Comparing and contrasting helps identify connections between characters and events.

Decoding Skill: Common Consonant Patterns - Digraphs

Some pairs of consonant letters have a single consonant sound, such as *-th*, *-ch*, *-sh*, *-wh*, *-ph*, *-ck*, and *-ng*.

When you see these digraphs next to each other, they often work together to make one sound. Do not separate into two different sounds, but blend them together to make one sound.
