Story Skill: Compare and Contrast

Decoding Skill: Common Consonant Patterns - Diagraphs

Some pairs of consonant letters have a single consonant sound, such as -th, -ch, -sh, -wh, -ph, -ck, and-ng.

When you see these digraphs next to each other, they often work together to make one sound. Do no separate into two different sounds, but blend them together to make one sound.
