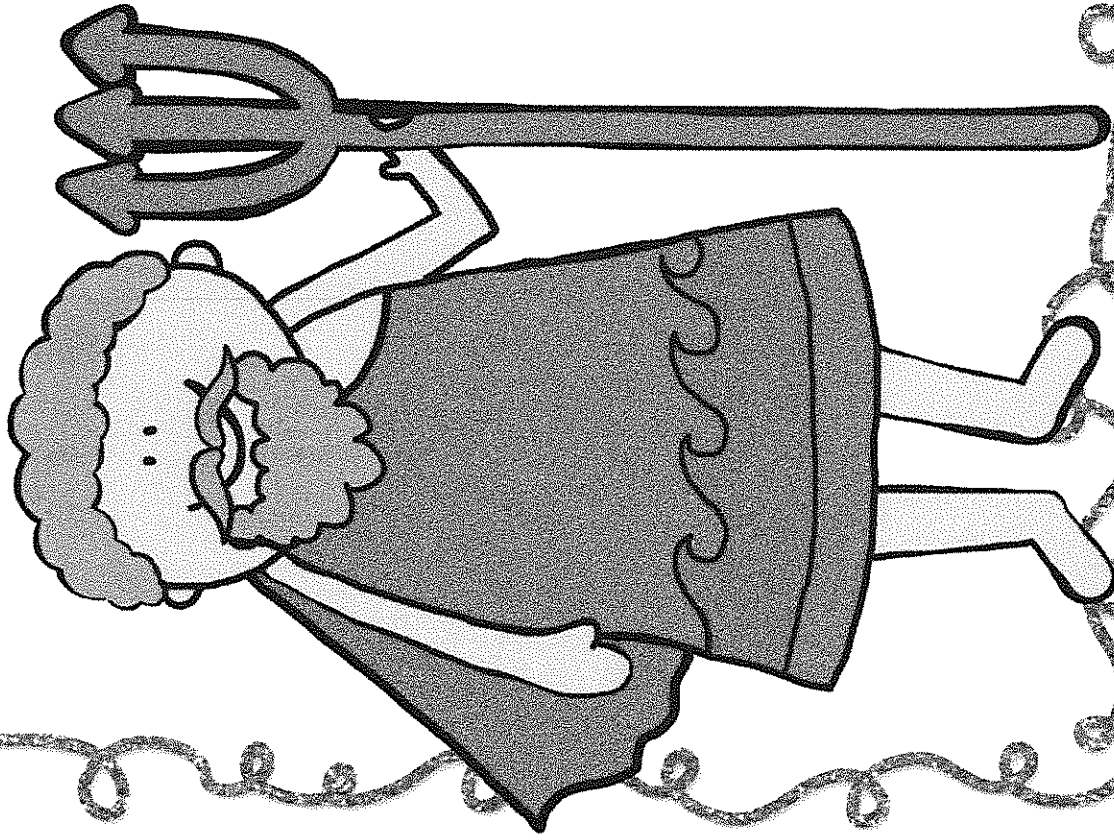


Poseidon ~ God of the Sea
